

CAMPING ASSEICEIRA – RULES AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We want our guests to have a safe and enjoyable stay at Camping Asseiceira. To try to ensure that this happens, and to meet Portuguese legal requirements, may we remind all guests to abide by the following rules and be aware of the important information included here:

You can access the Reception 24 hours per day. It contains a First Aid Kit, list of Emergency telephone numbers and other resources. It should be manned between the hours of 08.00h to 10.00h and 15.00h to 17.30h during winter months. 08.00h to 10.00h and 13.00h to 18.00h during Summer months.

All guests must register on arrival unless the reception is un-manned.

The maximum speed limit throughout the site is 10 km/h.

All visitors should familiarize themselves with the location of the fire extinguishers, fire exits and first aid kit. Please ask if you are unsure.

Children must be supervised at all times.

You must ensure that there is at least 3 metres between all pitches.

Barbecues are only permitted if you have equipment specifically designed for this purpose and they should always be raised above ground level. Open fires are not permitted at any time.

Dogs must be kept under control at all times. It is the dog owners responsibility to clean up any pet waste immediately. Pets should never be left unattended.

Noise should be kept to a minimum between the hours of 22.00hrs and 07.00hrs. No generators are permitted to run during this time. Music or any other noise should be at a level which does not disturb other guests at anytime.

Rubbish should be sorted into the appropriately identified containers. Chemical waste should be disposed of using the specific tank at the rear of the shower block. Please do your best to ensure that the premises are safe and clean for others.

Use the washroom and facilities with care. Please turn off taps that are not in use and switch off lights etc.

Departures should take place between the hours of 07.30h and 12.30h (07.30h and 10.30h for B&B guests). Arrivals will be accepted up to 19.30hrs. Exceptional permission outside of these hours is possible, but only with prior agreement.

Payment should be made in cash in full the day before departure.

Use of the campsite, accommodation, car park, and all other facilities is at the user's risk. Camping Asseiceira (Campceira Sociedade Unipessoal Lda), will not be held responsible for any accidents that may occur. Guests are responsible for loss, damage or theft of their own property at all times.

The campsite management has full legal rights to evict any guests who do not respect these rules.
